3. Employment Type

4. General Job Description

The Senior Analyst shall be responsible for leading the Real Estate Management Division and support the Land & Real Estate Department in ensuring effective and efficient operational services to the clients. The position reports to the Director of the Department.

5. Specific Responsibilities

The Senior Analyst, as the Head of the Real Estate Management Division (REMD), shall specifically be responsible for the following:

- Conduct periodic market intelligence to identify trends in the real estate industry, including the regional market.
- Conduct business analyses pertaining to property acquisitions or dispositions within the existing portfolio of assets (land and building only).
- Oversee lease agreements, property documents, and other legal instruments and assess risk and compliance for the land and landed properties as per the existing rules;
- Manage dispute settlement of issues pertaining to land and landed properties and liaise with external agencies where necessary;
- Assist in the preparation of budget forecasts, and financial plans for Land and Real Estate Department;

- Monitor and evaluate the performance of real estate investments periodically, including tracking key performance indicators and conducting variance analysis;
- Collaborate with cross-functional teams of GNY to ensure smooth implementation of planned activities/projects;
- Conduct due diligence processes for the land and real estate transactions, including reviewing property records, conducting site visits, and coordinating with external agencies;
- Keep track of the industry trends, regulations, and best practices in real estate to provide strategic recommendations and insights to the organization;
- Prepare land utilization plan and review on a timely basis to plan LRED investments;
- Prepare reports and presentations for the management to communicate findings, recommendations, and insights related to land and real estate activities; and
- Perform such other assignments, as required by the management from time to time.
